IMPORT CONDITIONS OF FROZEN CANINE SEMEN TO FINLAND

In Finnish veterinary legislation there are no animal health requirements for importation of frozen canine semen to Finland.

Only a commercial document including the information about the product (canine semen), the amount, and the names and addresses of the consignee and consigner must follow the consignment.

Veterinary border inspection is required when canine semen enters EU territory.

These import conditions are in force for the time being. If there are any changes, this document will be updated accordingly. There are no changes foreseen to the legislation, and in case anyone might import canine semen based on this document found in the internet website of Finnish Food Safety Authority Evira, the Veterinary Border Inspection Division will allow the consignment to be imported despite of the date of the signature.
