#### IV. Attestation of wholesomeness

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian do hereby certify that:

- (1) Finland is recognised by the OIE as having a negligible BSE risk according to Resolution N. 22 of the 77<sup>th</sup> General Session in May 2009, satisfying the conditions in Chapter 11.6 of the Terrestrial Animal Health Code.
- (2) Finland has been free from Foot and Mouth Disease and Rinderpest for 6 months immediate prior to the date of slaughter of animals and the date of export of the product to Singapore
- (3) The animals, from which the meat was derived, were born, reared and slaughtered in Finland; or in the case of imported animals, the animals may originate from other EU Member States of equivalent BSE risk as Finland (i.e. negligible BSE risk according to OIE as stated in condition 1 above) and have been approved for export of beef and beef products to Singapore.
- (4) The animals, from which the meat was derived, were subject to *ante-mortem* and *post-mortem* examination and were found to be free from infectious and contagious diseases.
- (5) The slaughter of the animals and processing, packing and storage of meat were carried out under sanitary conditions under official veterinary supervision in the above-mentioned establishments approved by the Director-General, Agri-Food and Veterinary Services for export to Singapore.
- (6) The meat has not been treated with chemical preservatives or foreign substances injurious to health.
- (7) The meat was found fit for human consumption and every precaution has been taken to prevent contamination prior to export.
